2. Crapaud Water & Sewer Utilities - CAO & Chair Mike Connolly

- Sept 2018: Sherwood Forest well site produced 995 m³ of water.
- Sept 2018: Lagoon treated 4,051 m³ of waste water.
- Sept 2018: 4 call out alarms.
- Bull rush removal is at 30%. Duckweed removal is at 70%.
- Issue with chicken plant sewer line. Larkin's is processing quicker than previous owner causing backups due to original undersized manhole. Estimate labour/machine at \$2,000+HST and Campbell's Concrete manhole at \$2,500+HST.
- **Motion:** Approve up to \$5,000+HST for new manhole to service Larkin's Bros poultry plant per procurement policy.
