 - 5.1. Council agrees details to be discussed and formalized with Lawyer, CEO and McQuaids and then presented to Council for Approval. Land will be sold at fair market value with covenants for type of building. Costs incurred to expand water and sewer to the property line to be paid for by the Community of Crapaud. Motion carried unanimously.

6. Tree Management in Crapaud – Councillor Baker

6.1. Mayor Auld presented the background surrounding a complaint received regarding trees being cut in Sherwood Forest. Stan added that after he investigated he found it was dead trees and brush that was cut. The individual was asked to stop cutting. After complaints received regarding trees being cut on municipal land it is suggested to include forestry management for the entire village in the tender to clear land in the new section of Sherwood Forest Subdivision.
